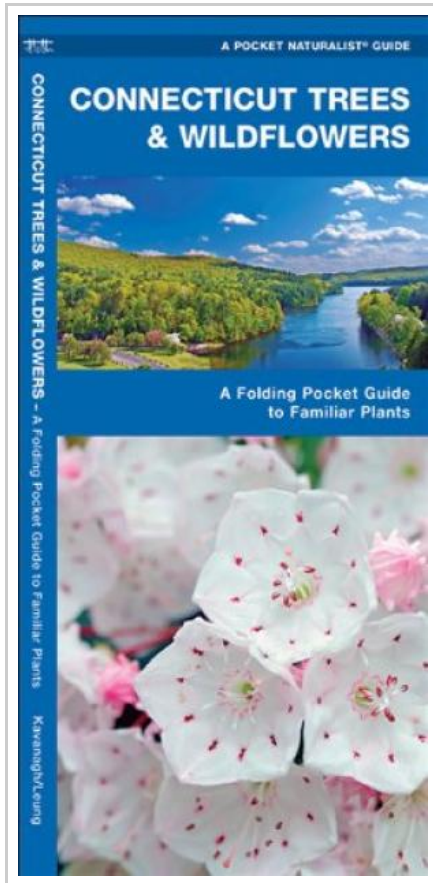




Connecticut Trees Wildflowers A Folding Pocket Guide to Familiar Species Pocket Naturalist Guide Series
