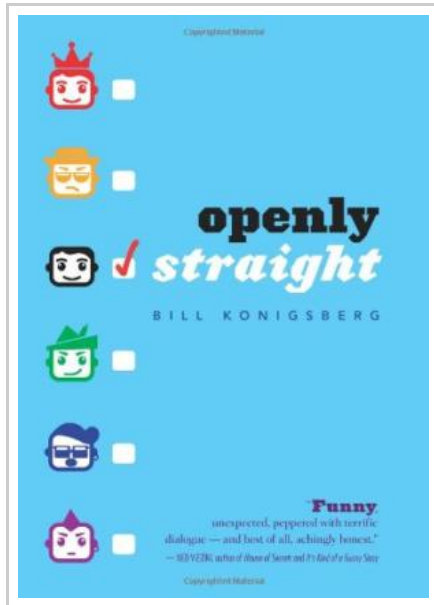




Openly Straight
