After being through him greatly edified in the word of God, and being blessed by the Lord, we were on Monday, the 5th September, 4 oclock p. m. , ordained by Pastor Gossner in the Bethlehems church before the Holy altar of the Lord in the presence of a large congregation; together with us there were also ordained two brethren, Gottlieb Noeser and Jul....
